- a. He resigns his office as a Trustee
- leave of absence to b. He fails without obtaining attend all the meetings of the Trustees held for six consecutive meetings, consecutive months or three whichever occurs later;
- c. He applies to be or is adjudged on insolvent or suspends payment to or makes a composition with his creditors;
